Maine Day Meal Pack Out

The University of Maine held their Maine Day Meal Pack-Out event again this year. Students from the Honors College raised funds to purchase bulk foods and held a meal pack out to help feed the food insecure of Maine as one of their Maine Day activities. Once again this year students volunteered their time to measure out and package the food into meals which are fortified with nutrients and have about a two year shelf life. They packed more than 100,000 meals in just a few hours. The Belfast Rotary Club financially supported this event. 55 cases containing 11,880 meals were brought back to Waldo County .



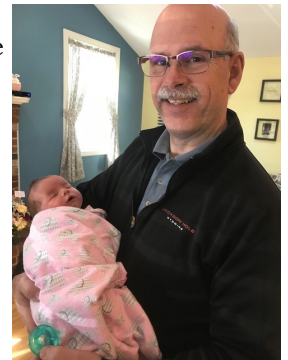
Meet the Rotarian: Greg Dutch
